IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 39 OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT AND DISPOSAL ACT, 2005: FOLLOWING THE GAZETTMENT OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT AND DISPOSAL (PREFERENCE AND RESERVATIONS) REGULATIONS, 2011

The Public Procurement and Disposal Act, 2005 (the Act) is aimed at facilitating the promotion of local industry and economic development by prescribing preference and reservations.

Consequently, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 140 of the Act, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance gazetted the Public Procurement and Disposal (Preference and Reservations) Regulations, 2011 vide Legal Notice No. 58 dated 8th June, 2011.
